

## Praying Psalm 100 over Your Prodigal

"Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands! Serve the LORD with gladness; come before His presence with singing. Know that the LORD, He is God; it is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful unto Him, and bless His name. For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations." (Psalm 100 NKJV)

May I take a little time to go through this step by step?
1. I pray that will make a joyful shout to the LORD!
2. I pray that will serve the LORD with gladness!
3. I pray that will come before His presence with singing!
4. I pray that will know that the LORD, He is God, and that he/she will no longer believe the lies of Satan that there is no God or that something or someone else is God.
5. I pray that will know that God has made us and not believe lies about creation.
6. I pray that will follow the Good Shepherd and be a sheep in His pasture.
7. I pray that will enter His gates with thanksgiving and be thankful unto God, realizing the many amazing things God has done for him/her!
8. I pray that will bless the name of the LORD and enter into His courts with praise, using the talents God has given to give Him praise!
9. I pray that will know the LORD as good!
10. I thank God that His mercy is everlasting toward!
11. I claim the promise that God's truth endures to all generations, including the generations that follow me!
Feel free to pray one of these that jumps out at you as pertaining to your prodigal. Maybe all of them are the cry of your heart, just like they are to me. Or perhaps you would choose to speak them over your prodigal, calling his/her name before each sentence. It is POWERFUL!
